Will you commit yourselves to creating an atmosphere of training in your home where you develop regular patterns of Faith Talks, Prayer Times, God Sightings and Living on Mission in order to continue on the Milestone Pathway? This will require that you intentionally work to lead your children using real life experiences as training moments and organized, planned environments to teach them to interpret all of life based on God's design for their lives. Since you cant do this alone it will require that you make every possible effort to take advantage of other ministries that are designed to to assist you in this training process.
 - 3. Will you, with God's help, pray regularly that by God's grace (Baby's Name) will come to trust in Jesus Christ alone for the forgiveness of his sins and for the fulfillment of all His promises to him, even eternal life; and in his faith follow Jesus as Lord in every area of his life?
 - 4. Do you promise to provide, through God's blessing, for the physical, emotional, intellectual, and spiritual needs of your children, looking to your own Heavenly Father for the wisdom, love and strength to serve them and not "use" them to meet your own longings and needs?
